

Our very own John Grusenmeyer of Sacred Heart parish will be ordained a transitional deacon this coming Saturday. Please keep John and his classmates in your prayers as they begin ministry in the Church and head into their final year of formation for priesthood.

Looking ahead: At the end of the Easter Season, we have the experience of celebrating several glorious moveable feasts four Sundays in a row: Ascension of our Lord, Pentecost, Most Holy Trinity, and Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ, also known as Corpus Christi. They are on different dates every year, but they are super important. I invite your family to think of creative ways to amplify the important mysteries we celebrate on these glorious feasts. For example, we find ourselves in the midst of a three-year Eucharistic Revival. Spiritual Communion




If You Can't Receive Communion, Make a Spiritual Communion

"Since I cannot at this moment receive you sacramentally, come at least spiritually into my heart."

Act of Spiritual Communion

The Church encourages frequent, even daily, Holy Communion, but if at any time we cannot go to Mass in or out of this season of the coronavirus, we can still unite ourselves to the Eucharist through making a spiritual Communion. By making an Act of Spiritual Communion, we express our faith in Christ's Real Presence in the Eucharist and ask him to unite himself with us. Here is the Act of Spiritual Communion written by St. Alphonsus de Liguori: My Jesus, I believe that You are present in the Most Holy Sacrament. I love You above all things, and I desire to receive You into my soul. Since I cannot at this moment receive You as if You were already there and unite myself wholly to You. Never permit me to be separated from You. **Amen.**






St. Vincent de Paul Thank You
