## FOURTH SUNDAY OF EASTER

Jesus calls himself the sheepgate. In some places in the world, one still comes upon mounds of earth piled in a circle topped by dry thorns. At night sheep are herded into the circle. The thorns keep out wolves and thieves – the shepherd hears the rattle of the thorns and defends the sheep. There are,

however, no gates to these broken circles. At night the shepherd sleeps blocking the opening. The shepherd is the sheepgate. We, too, have a dual function. We are both sheep and apostles. As sheep, we are returned by the suffering of Christ to the shepherd, the guardian of our souls. As apostles, we are called to use our every gift to add to the Church's growth.

I heard from the priest personnel board that we will be getting a newly ordained priest to serve our family of parishes beginning July 1. We thank Fr. Jedidiah for serving us this spring and please join me in praying for him and all the newly ordained priests.

Please keep in your prayers the children who will make their First Holy Communion the next couple of weekends. May they hunger for the Lord and receive him worthily early and often.

Tomorrow, Monday, already begins the month of May, which is dedicated to the Blessed Virgin Mary. Full of grace, she is the greatest of all saints, who always leads us to her Son. The Church has a rich history of devotions to help us imitate her virtues. In which devotions will you and your family participate?

Our very own Kevin LeMelle, seminary intern, will be speaking at Theology on Tap this coming Thursday, May 4<sup>th</sup> at the Oregon Express in Dayton. Come early to order food and drinks. Talks begin at 7:00PM.

I recently attended an event the Archbishop held where some of his guests spoke of efforts to lead people of faith in overcoming the evil ballot initiative that would erase restrictions on ending the life of the unborn and diminish parental consent for children's surgeries by changing the constitution of the State of Ohio. Ohio is essentially a test case for people in 11 other states planning similar evils in 2024. Ohio is the seventh most populous state in the union, so what happens here is a big deal. Please support the raffle and the festival—you make the festival a huge success every year!


