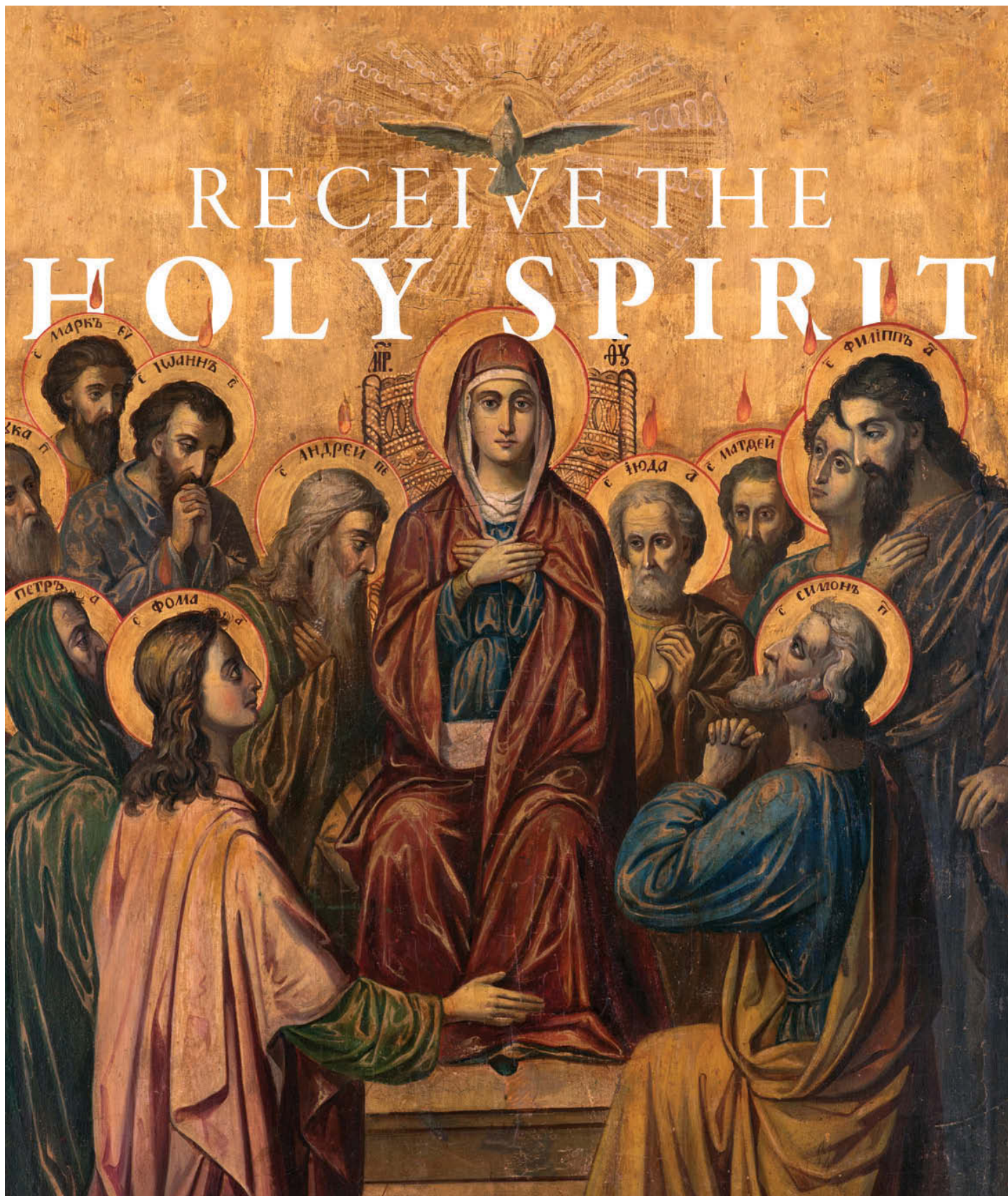

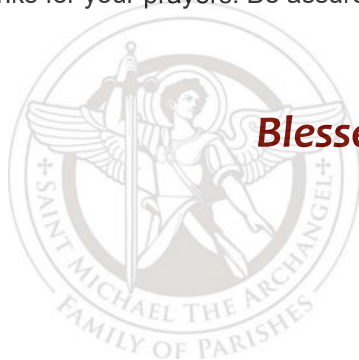
## Beloved in Christ,

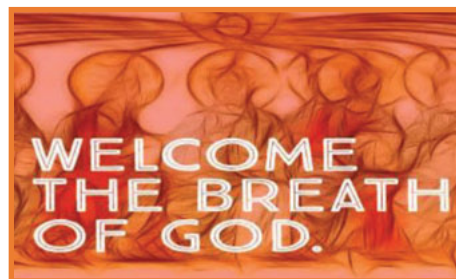


## OFFERING OPTION



A few of our parishioners have their offerings to our parish set up as "automatic" checks from their banking institution. We receive a check from their banking institution at set times and for set amounts, as predetermined by the parishioner. This type of giving saves the parishioner from writing manual checks and also does not cost the parish anything. The automatic checks are posted to our parishioner's donation record, just as if a manual check had been written. If you think you might be interested in this option for your support of the parish, please ask your bank to help you set this up. We are told it is very easy. Most online offering programs typically charge the parish a 4%-5% fee off the top. If we used that type of program, an offering of \$50.00 would yield about \$47.50. Instead, we avoid this fee by receiving automatic checks, as described above. Thanks to all our parishioners for your continued support of our parish.

## EVENTS & ACTIVITIES

### LITURGICAL COLORS



Have you ever wondered why the colors in our church change throughout the year? Each color symbolizes a liturgical season or a particular day in our church calendar. The colors also represent particular qualities. This Sunday, the fifty-day Easter season will conclude with Pentecost, the birthday of the Church. Our colors will be red to symbolize the flames of the Holy Spirit. After Pentecost Sunday, we will begin the second round of Ordinary (as in ordered or numbered) Time, which is green this will start on June 10. We have some very important Solemnities on Sunday, June 15 the Solemnity of the Most Holy Trinity, and Sunday, June 22 the Solemnity of the Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ (Corpus Christi), which require white, not green as the liturgical color. After that, you will begin to see the green on Sundays. Are you still asking why white or why green? Green symbolizes the hope we have with faith. White symbolizes Christ, purity, victory over death and joy among other things, and therefore, used for our most holy solemnities and seasons. Stay tuned for more color explanations late this fall when we look toward Advent.
