Beloved in Christ,

In a recent Flocknote, I shared how we can spiritually and financially support the people of St. John the Baptist Church in Maria Stein whose church was **destroyed by fire** on May 29. This is my first chance to share it via the bulletin.

The Archdiocese set up a website (see the address and QR code on the next page) as a convenient way to **give between now and July 13** directly online. It is also possible to give at any parish as long as the gift is clearly marked for the St. John Fund. Thank you for your generous witness.

Perpetual Eucharistic Adoration begins today (Sunday) in St. Dominic Chapel, the old St. Luke Church. The web address and QR code to sign up and **spend some time with Our Eucharistic Lord** is also on the next page.

This Tuesday, June 24, we celebrate the **Solemnity of the Nativity of St. John the Baptist**. He went to his death for speaking out about the truth of the dignity of marriage and family.

Tuesday also marks the **third anniversary of the Dobbs decision** from the Supreme Court. We celebrate that the court decreed that the Constitution of the United States does not confer a right to end the life of the child in the womb. However, since the Dobbs decision, Ohio and many other states sadly changed their constitutions to include the right to end the life of the child in the womb.

Ohio has even become an abortion destination for people from other states. The witness **stories of women who contemplated abortion**, and even went through with it, very often mention the impact of the people praying peacefully on the sidewalk at the abortion facility. We can save lives by doing just that here locally at 1401 E. Stroop Rd. in Kettering.

This Friday, June 27, is the Solemnity of the Sacred Heart of Jesus the **patronal feast of Sacred Heart Church**. All are welcome to the bilingual Mass, beginning at 7 p.m., and the following reception. More detail is on page 9.






DONUTS THIS WEEKEND The definition of "hospitality" refers to the practice of warmly welcoming and







The Most Sacred Heart of Jesus




