



# Beloved in Christ,

**Welcome Fr. Uriel!** He joins our Family this Tuesday, July 1 (photo on page 9). May he have a blessed ministry here in the St. Michael the Archangel Family of Parishes!

Traditionally, new metropolitan archbishops receive the pallium on today's Solemnity of Saints Peter and Paul. The pallium is a small wool vestment that fits loosely around the neck. It symbolizes Jesus, the Good Shepherd who puts the lost sheep on his shoulders with loving care.

Pallium imposition occurs on this solemnity because the two great pastors, **Saints Peter and Paul**, were ready to lay down their lives for the sheep. (Interesting side note: Sheep selected to provide wool for the pallia are blessed in January on the feast of St. Agnes, whose name means "lamb.")

Our very own **Archbishop Casey** is a new metropolitan archbishop. He is scheduled to be in Rome today to receive his pallium from Pope Leo.

What makes our archbishop "metropolitan?" Good question. There are six dioceses in Ohio, one of which is the Archdiocese of Cincinnati. The other five are suffragan dioceses in the Province of Cincinnati, which is geographically the State of Ohio.

The archbishop in Cincinnati is not the boss of

the other five bishops, but he has the task of installing new bishops whenever the other five would become vacant. Cincinnati is the metropolitan archdiocese with the metropolitan archbishop.

The archbishops of the world who serve in some other capacity rather than archdiocesan administration do not get a pallium; Archbishops of the Roman Curia who work in the Vatican for example.

This Friday, we celebrate **Independence Day**. What better way to thank God for the freedoms we enjoy than by participating at Mass? Four of our parishes offer Mass Friday at the usual times.



#### **Procedure to Borrow Tables**






