

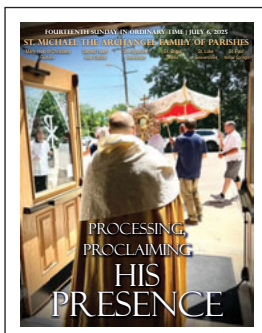

Beloved in Christ,

Events are infrequent at our churches this time of year. So, let me cover some of the topics that have been presented to me.

A few weeks ago, all the Extraordinary Ministers of Holy Communion (EMHC) had opportunities for training and retraining. They were also commissioned and recommissioned. One EMHC expressed gratitude for the refresher and said, "This is great, but could you also remind the faithful **how to receive communion?**"

It all begins before we get to Mass. We need to discern if we plan to receive Holy Communion. We must fast for at least an hour before receiving. **This includes all food, drink, gum, and coffee.** However, we do not break the fast with water or necessary medicine.

Once the fast is intact, we further discern if we are conscious of a grave sin since our last confession. If we are, we do not present ourselves for communion until we get to confession. This includes **missing Mass on Sunday or holy days** of obligation without a good reason like sickness, deep snow, etc.

In presenting ourselves for communion, the universal practice is receiving on the tongue while standing. However, a variation to each is acceptable. For example, in the United States, we have the dispensation of receiving on the hand. Please keep in mind **while traveling abroad** that this is not the case in every country, so we wouldn't want to offend.

If receiving on the hand, the communicant places **one hand over the other in the form of a cross** as flat as possible. Once the minister places the sacred host on the top hand, the communicant uses the bottom hand to pick up the sacred host and receive it right there in the presence of the minister.

The Church also has a long tradition of communicants receiving while kneeling, which continues as an option. To this end, we have **kneelers in place.**

If you are unsure about how to receive or how to have communion brought to a sick person, please call any parish office.

Thanks for your prayers. Be assured of my daily prayers for you.

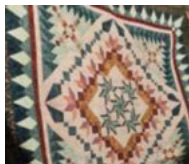

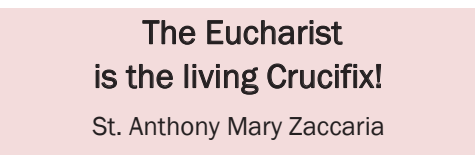
